The AMF warns investors against the company EXELYUM LTD.

The AMF is warning investors to be aware of the activities of EXELYUM Ltd, whose headquarters are located at 105 Sham Peng Tong Plaza, Victoria, Mahé, Seychelles.

The company is offering contracts to trade on behalf of investors in various markets including the currency futures market (Forex). The contracts lure investors with the prospect of high yields at low risk, for example returns of 1.5% per month with capital guaranteed in exchange for investing for a fixed term of one year.

The AMF is warning investors against these unrealistic proposals, made by a company not authorised to provide investment services in France.

Consequently the AMF recommends that investors do not respond to these invitations, enter into contracts or pass on these investment proposals to others.

Do not believe any advertising message suggesting that there are high returns without high risk. Any product suggesting a rate of return higher than the money market rate (investors may also refer to the interest rate on a savings account such as the "Livret A" in France) necessarily carries significant risk.
